MISSION STATEMENT

Fulton County Supporters of the Gifted (FCSG) is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit association dedicated to supporting gifted students and their teachers through academic camp scholarships and teacher grants for materials and programs that benefit those students. FCSG advocates for additional funding for gifted programs. Membership is open to all certified Talented and Gifted Teachers and families of those students who are eligible for gifted services in Fulton County Schools.

VISION STATEMENT

Academic courses for gifted students should be designed to challenge them based on their unique interests and talents. Class sizes for academically gifted students should be kept at or below the state maximum class size for gifted students given the increased challenge of working with students who require individualized attention and differentiated course material. TAG teachers should have the freedom to expand the standard curriculum to adapt it to the abilities of the gifted student and present those students with a curriculum that enhances their creativity and innate love of learning.
